meant they were free to bother the spinners and frequently engaged in setting fire to the flax and tow. The spinners kept pails of water handy to douse the fire and the firebug.

### ***Recipe for the Month of January***

#### **Pork Roast in Ale Sauce**

2 1/2 lbs. pork loin joint on the bone  
2 lg. cloves of garlic, peeled and crushed  
1/2 tsp. salt  
1 cup ale

Pre-heat oven to 425°F. Strip the skin off the pork joint and prick the fat all over with a knifepoint. Mix garlic, salt and ale and rub the meat all over with the mixture. lay the joint on a doubled sheet of foil big enough to enclose it. Fasten the edges of the foil around the meat, leaving an open space at the top. Pour remaining spice/ale mixture over the meat, close foil.

Reduce heat to 350°F. Allow 30 min. per lb. plus 30 min. Open foil during the last 30 min. to brown surface of meat. Remove from oven to a warm serving dish. Serve.

### ***Queen's Champion's Tourney to be Held in February***

As I'm sure you all have heard by now, there will be a tournament to determine the Queen's Champion in February. The combat portion of the tournament will consist of three knight's list tourneys. A knight's list shinai tourney will be fought in addition to the normal sarjeant's list shinai tourney, so that the sarjeant's will still have their chance to participate in their tourney and may graduate to the knight's list. The ren

and steel tourneys will be dedicated to determining the Queen's Champion, along with the knight's shinai list.

Scoring will be as follows. Entering any Champion's list will earn the combatant one point. A first place finish in the knight's shinai list will earn the combatant two additional points. A second place showing in the knight's shinai list will earn the combatant one additional point. A first place finish in the Ren list will earn the combatant three additional points. A second place finish in Ren will earn the combatant two additional points and a third place finish in that list will earn the combatant one additional point. In steel, the first place finisher receives four points, the second place finisher three points, the third place finisher two points and the fourth place finisher one point. Third and fourth place finishes in both ren and steel will be determined by a bout between the two losing combatants from the semi-final round.

The overall victor will be determined by who has the most points. In the event of a tie, the tied combatants will fight a simple, sudden death bout or tourney to determine the final victor.

### ***Favors, Tokens, and Belt Danglies***

It's a common practice to give, and to wear, favors on your belt. Many times these are wonderful embroidered pieces of artwork. How

many of you are aware that those types of favors aren't what they really used to give and receive as tokens of esteem and affection?

Alianora Munro has written a wonderful article on the subject: A Survey of Tokens in the Middle Ages and Renaissance. What's better for a computer geek like me is that she has posted it on her website:

[http://members.aol.com/\\_ht\\_a/noramunro/Tokens/index.htm](http://members.aol.com/_ht_a/noramunro/Tokens/index.htm). I've used Ms. Munro in some of my own arts documentation as an expert in the field. (Before I would quote her, though, I double-checked her sources, quotes and conclusions.) I found her to be thorough, accurate and fun to read. I don't hesitate for a moment to recommend this article to everyone who is interested!

"What is the history of the token in the Middle Ages and Renaissance? To begin, the SCA "fingertip towel" token worn on the belt has no basis in medieval practice. How or when it came into being I do not know, but it seems to be a strictly SCA phenomenon. Mediaeval tokens were also were not, as is frequently the case in SCA practice, strictly gifts of a lady to her champion. A knight might equally give his lady a token of affection. The history of tokens is traceable through both literature and artifacts, and spans much of the mediaeval and Renaissance periods in Europe."

### ***Kingdom of Terre Neuve Collegia Day***

Announcing a Collegia to be held at Garden Road Park, Poway, January 26, starting at 9:30 am.

Alternate rainout site is at the home of Dame Juliana and Sir Arion. This event is in costume. Bring lunch.

This Collegia is geared toward information for newer members, but old timers are encouraged to come and participate. Guilds are encouraged to provide handout information on an info table. Most of the classes will be discussion group

format and will be relatively short classes with handouts.

1) Basics of Adrian Culture - Baron Nigel Seymour of Huntington, Marquis della Allianz del Norte

Introduces the history and organization of the Empire, how the government works, how decisions are made, where manuals and information can be found, what titles are, and an overview of the ranking system. Discusses Adria as a Chivalric society, fealty relationships in Adria, including Man-at-Arms, Squire, and vassal relationships. Discusses historical recreation and the concept of "suspension of disbelief".

2) Persona Development - Baron Nigel Seymour of Huntington, Marquis della Allianz del Norte, Dame Juliana Hirsch, Countess Tresoli and Sir Klaus van Isbjerg

Introduction to a persona, how to choose a persona within the Adrian context, choosing a period name, culture and heraldry, how to add to the medieval environment by with period accoutrements, accessories and heraldry.

3) The Ranking System - HRM Marcella Visconti

Introduces how ranks are gained in Adria, how points are earned, where is the information kept, how paperwork is managed, and basic forms and reports. Discusses the concept of joining estates and Squiring.

4) Courtly Behavior for Crown and Populace - Baron Nigel Seymour of Huntington, Marquis della Allianz del Norte

Introduces courtly behavior, forms of address, how a basic court is run, what not to do in Court, basic field courtesy.

5) Bylaws - HRM Marcella Visconti

Introduces the Bylaws, where do you find them, how do the Bylaws relate to the average member, how does the Adrian legal system work, who interprets the Law, and how are conflicts resolved in Adria.

6) Heraldry - Baron Nigel Seymour of Huntington, Marquis della Alleanza del Norte  
Introduction to period heraldry, the difference between book and field Heraldry, Adrian heraldic submissions, and heraldic sumptuaries. Discussion of period names. Discussion of the Office of Herald.

7) Arts - Dame Juliana Hirsch, Countess Tresoli  
Introduces the arts competition, basic documentation, how things are judged, what an entrant should expect, etiquette in the arts. Introduces guilds.

8) Combat - Sir Arion Hirsch, Baron Hoffbrau, HRM Rhys ap Thomas (and other Knight combattants)  
Introduces combat, basic gear, the authorization process, field etiquette, the Marshal's role on the field, and basic sportsmanship. Discusses how tournaments are different from wars. Introduces guilds.

9) Archery- TBD  
Introduces combat and target archery, basic gear, range etiquette, the Rangemaster's role on the field, and basic sportsmanship.

10) Music in the Middle Ages and Renaissance- David Whittaker and Janet Whittaker  
Introduction to medieval musical instruments and period music. Play and sing along.

11) Intro to Costume and Consultation - Dame Juliana Hirsch, Countess Tresoli and Sir Klaus van Isbjerg  
Introduction to costume, period fabrics, period fashions, where does someone find more information on appropriate costume. Consultation on costume designs and fabrics.

12) Chivalry Roundtable - Dame Juliana Hirsch, Countess Tresoli (all Knights are encouraged to participate)  
Introduces period concepts of Chivalry from period authors, and how they relate to Chivalry within Adria. Open discussion about chivalry and expectations of the Order of Chivalry.

I have read the job description and in doing so, I have updated the Event Request Form which is attached to this newsletter. I will ask that pending Autocrats use this form and following the simple rules. I have tried the website and it works great! Be sure to use the /evt-request.asp

path as it will come right up on the system and when you submit the request it arrives on my e-mail in 3 minutes. Your DI point may depend on following the time line. The most important item to understand is that as an Autocrat you may not sign documents for the kingdom. This is a mundane corporate process and should not be taken lightly. If you give me information in passing and I do not have pen and paper in hand you take a great risk in my memory retention.

We were either demoless last year or we did not follow the guidelines or we improvised a lot. For as compared to this first month, the calendar and collegiums are growing. The black box is not empty anymore.

As you are aware, we are now being charged a fee for the use of Eisenhower Park. I have been advised all parks in the City of Orange and Orange County require such a fee. I have secured maps for Southern California parks and recreation areas and will be checking other locations for normal event use and wars etc. There are many and to check them all out will take a very long time. Any recommendations will be greatly appreciated - some of the criteria to keep in mind: This is a family function for many and the safety and functionality for children is important. Many of us bring non-participants and their comfort is to be considered. The ability to park the cars close to the site as some of us pack full trucks. Close proximity to the main freeways. Centralization for the benefit of all members - Lock Lave is 3 hours to Eisenhower Park; Aquitaine (Riverside area) is 30 minutes +/- There is a high interest in target archery. Available restrooms and lighting for those short Estates Meetings.

I would request that anyone who travels more than 1 hour please e-mail and advises me so I can start marking the outlining areas. I am aware of the eastern groups but not too sure about the western population.

***The Minister of Joust & War's office***  
Greetings, Good Populace,

Last month we had an excellent turnout. We ran all three lists and announced plans to change things up slightly in the future, just to keep it interesting. The winners at the crown tourney were Reinhart in both the Shinai and Armored lists and Sir Donovan in the Ren list.

The January Aquitaine tourney also went very well with a good turnout and all three combat lists run. The victory in Shinai went to Dame Marion, who has now graduated to the knight's list. Victory in both Ren and Steel went to Sir Jamie the Red.

At the December crown tourney, there was some heated discussion on the field during the finals of the Ren tourney. All combatants are expected to follow the rules and to heed the words of the marshals. It is a part of the sword oath and it will be enforced in future. If you argue with a marshal, you can and will be removed from the field.

Much of the discussion was based on some confusion generated by the method of

determining a final victor. In the future, when there are three finalists, we will use one of the following three methods to determine the victor. First, simple, sudden death. All three combatants take the field and the last man standing wins. Second, three lives. Combatants fight in pairs. Each combatant has three lives. The last man who still has a life wins. In the event of a final double-kill, we revert to simple, sudden death. Third, the destructive bye. The odd combatant fights against a combatant who has already lost to determine if he may challenge the victor of a bout between the other two. If he wins, there is a final battle, if he loses, then the victor of the bout between the other two combatants decides the victor. If anyone finds any of these methods confusing or unfair in any way, come talk to me. I am always open to suggestions.
