A Mad Dog list is a bit like an informal round robin.

- A large list field is staked out; combatants are free to enter the list field, find a marshal and pick a fight.
- The two combatants then report the results of the combat to the list person who keeps track of how many wins each combatant has.
- Sometimes points are assigned to a combatant based on his rank (e.g. Sergeants are worth 1, Knights are worth 2). The victorious combatant gets the number of points the defeated combatant is worth.
- The combatant with the most point at the end of the day is declared the winner.

There will be games for children and adults!!
